The first report card of the school year is enclosed with this newsletter. The grading scale is:

90 to 100	Excellent work
80 to 89	Above average work
70-79	Average work
65 to 69	Below average work and in danger of failing
Below 65	Failing work.

If your son did well, congratulations are certainly in order to both him and to you. First Honors certificates are awarded to students who attain an average of 90.0 and no mark below 85. Second Honors are awarded to those with an average of 85.0 and no mark below 80.

If your son received any marks that are failing (below 65) or close to failing (below 70), it is important for parents to take steps to ensure an improvement. The teacher's comments give some guidance in this regard. More detailed information can be obtained by meeting with the teachers at parent-teacher conferences on Thursday, November 20, between 5 and 7 PM. Please reserve the date on your calendar.
